Law Enforcement Officer of the Year Award

Each Sheriff can submit <u>one nomination</u>, with the exception of a team effort by two individuals. In that event, a team nomination will be treated as one nomination. The criteria may include, but not be limited to:

- * one or more heroic acts
- * high personal standards and service above and beyond the call of duty
- * "technical" excellence (law enforcement)
- * innovation/initiative in creating a new or innovative law enforcement program
- * outstanding efforts in criminal investigation
- * outstanding narcotics investigation
- * lifetime achievement
- * other exemplary performance as deemed by the Sheriff

The act(s) for which a nomination is made should have been accomplished during the previous calendar year. However, nominations may be submitted for a Lifetime Achievement award, in which event the acts would be over the career of the individual being nominated. The Lifetime Achievement award honors individuals for his/her significant and creative contributions to the field of corrections. If you wish to nominate a law enforcement officer for the Lifetime Achievement Award, please note that your recommendation is for this award on the application.
