



# Florida Sheriffs **TASK FORCE** Operation Safe Steps

**Pedestrian safety is not just about motorists –  
pedestrians must also comply with the State Laws.  
Violations of these laws can result in fines.**

## **FSS 316.130 (2)**

Pedestrians must obey traffic signals (walk/don't walk)

## **FSS 316.130 (3)**

Pedestrians must walk on sidewalk, not the roadway

## **FSS 316.130 (7)**

When no traffic lights exist at a marked crosswalk,  
vehicles shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians  
in the crosswalk

## **FSS 316.130 (11)**

Where signals are in operation, pedestrians shall not cross  
at any other place than at a crosswalk



# Florida Sheriffs **TASK FORCE** Operation Safe Steps

**Did you know that Florida is one of the most dangerous states in the Nation for pedestrians?\***  
To keep yourself safe always remember to ***WALK WISE.***

**W**alk without distraction, wait to text or talk on phone

**A**lways follow the walk/don't walk signals

**L**ook left, right and then left again before crossing

**K**now your surroundings

**W**ear bright colors – be seen night and day

**I**mpaired walking can be dangerous

**S**tay on sidewalks – walk facing traffic

**E**xpect the unexpected – walk defensively
